These files are often requested by professional print houses as well as companies needing a VERY clear image of your logo. These files have a transparent background.

jpg and png files are bitmapped files and may be used no larger than supplied for clarity.

This file is used for social media, website, blog, e-newsletters. It also prints pretty clearly as long as it is not increased in size. png file has a transparent background.
