Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 1998 and has been awarded to 27 Wayne County graduates over the past 11 years. This scholarship is the most prestigious award the Foundation issues. The scholarship will fund full tuition, required fees, and an allocation of up to \$800 per year for required books and equipment for four years of full-time undergraduate study leading to a baccalaureate degree at any Indiana public or private college or university accredited by the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

- The program is open to all Wayne County residents who will have graduated by the end of June 2010 from an accredited Indiana high school
- The scholarship applicant must be accepted to a full-time baccalaureate course of study beginning in the fall of 2010 at an accredited Indiana public or private university or college
- The scholarship applicant must have a minimum **3.0 cumulative** grade point average on a 4.0 scale at the time of application

- The scholarship applicant must complete and submit the application to your Guidance Counselor on or before **January 6, 2010.**

***Please note** late applications may not be considered by the selection committee.*

A completed application should contain the following:

- Application typed or printed in ink
- Applicant and parent signatures on application (page 2)
- Transcript dated December 2009 or after including cumulative GPA, class rank and SAT or ACT scores
- Completed College Cost Estimator
- Only three (3) completed recommendations
- Completed Essay (not to exceed 1 page)
