Sport stacking: Craig sets county record of 9.03 seconds

Caleb Craig of Western Wayne Elementary set a new Wayne County record as the sixth grader took the gold with a time of 9.03 seconds during the seventh annual Wayne County Sport Stacking Tournament at Western Wayne Elementary School.

Craig was one of the 10 fastest stackers in the cycle competition in Wayne County. Jayden Bussell took the silver, while Seth Morris claimed the bronze. Also in the top 10 were Rachel Merida, Maddie Black, Hannah Berry, Elijah Halcomb, Taylor Gregory, Kylee Smith and Erich Vernon.

Emily Merida earned the gold in the 3-6-3 stacking competition in 5.34 seconds. Jarret Thornburg took the silver and Joshua Campbell the bronze. Also in the top 10 were Andrew Cottrell, Shayna Morris, Bryce Lamar, Bailey Puckett, Alex Bertsch, Mikah Hale and Marie Gerkin.

Tournament proceeds provide scholarships through the Ellen M. Lane Memorial Fund at the **Wayne County Foundation**.

This year's tournament featured 113 registered Wayne County competitors in grades K-12.
