The Wayne County Foundation has announced its annual awards for 2014. The recipients will be honored at a June 25 dinner at Forest Hills Country Club, 2169 S. 23rd St. in Richmond.

The Ruth J. Wickemeyer Award for Community Service will be presented to Aileen Wickett-Harris, longtime volunteer coordinator of the community kitchen at St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Richmond. Her nomination letter said Wickett-Harris has been "quietly addressing the issues of hunger in Wayne County for 20 years."

She also organizes a monthly community dinner at Webster United Methodist, her home church.

Mary Alice Adney and her late husband, Dr. Frank Adney, will receive the Charles A. Rodefled Award for Leadership in Philanthropy and the Community.

The Adneys supported the work of local non-profit organizations for many years. In its nomination letter, the Richmond Art Museum described Mary Alice Adney as "the epitome of someone who has improved the effectiveness of several existing charitable institutions while maintaining an attitude of humility."
