Return to the Foundation by Monday, **April 16, 2007**.

- 1) Specific description of time and effort contributed, financial support given and/or received as a result of those efforts.
- 2) Description of specific achievements such as new programs launched, problems addressed, etc.
- 3) Evidence of encouragement and motivation given to others to take leadership roles toward philanthropy and community involvement.
