## WAYNE COUNTY FOUNDATION SET TO AWARD \$230,000 WITHIN 2016 CHALLENGE MATCH PROGRAM

## Forty-Six Organizations Selected to Participate

The Wayne County Foundation announced today the organizations selected to participate in its 2016 Challenge Match Initiative. It is the largest field of participants in the program's five year history.

The one-to-one match offers the possibility of generating over \$500,000 for 46 non-profit organizations throughout the Wayne County community. It is specifically designed to help organizations trigger support from the Foundation in relation to the contributions they receive from the community.

"We believe this is a good opportunity for many different organizations to raise significant operating dollars or money in support of selected programs that will benefit from broad-based community involvement," said Steve Borchers, the Foundation's executive director.

This will be the fifth year for the Challenge Match. Last year the program generated nearly \$780,000 for 27 local non-profits on \$200,000 of available match dollars from the Foundation.

"Thanks to some very generous Match Partners we are able to support more organizations than ever before, "said Borchers. Even so, not everyone who applied was accepted.

"We wanted to keep the Challenge Match challenging," said Borchers, "and we wanted to inspire thoughtful, high-quality applications. Every one of the 51 applications we received was judged against four selection criteria that we announced earlier this year."

One change this year was that organizations could apply for a smaller match amount without the usual threshold requirement. Even so, Borchers is quick to point out that the match goal is not a limit to what an organization can raise. "The sum of the match goals only represents the Foundation's total level of participation. We hope that every organization exceeds its goal by a wide margin."
